

State of Utah Division of Water Quality Announces Grant Recipients

The State Division of Water Quality recently announced recipients for watershed improvement grants. Seven projects facilitated by Arne Hultquist, the Southeast Utah Watershed Coordinator, and submitted through the Moab Area Watershed Partnership (MAWP) were successfully funded. The total funding for all seven projects is over \$220,000.

The projects and their sponsors are as follows: Pinhook Fire Watershed Restoration, David Erley and the town of Castle Valley; Castle Creek Stream Bank Restoration, David Erley and the Town of Castle Valley; Pack Creek Stream Bank Restoration, Moab City; Invasive re-vegetation on Pack and Mill Creek, Kara Dohrenwend and Rim to Rim Restoration; Mill Creek Riparian Restoration, Ann Marie Aubry and the Bureau of Land Management; La Sal Mountains Spring Development, Tina Marian and the United States Forest Service. Included in the grant was funding for the MAWP coordinator position.
